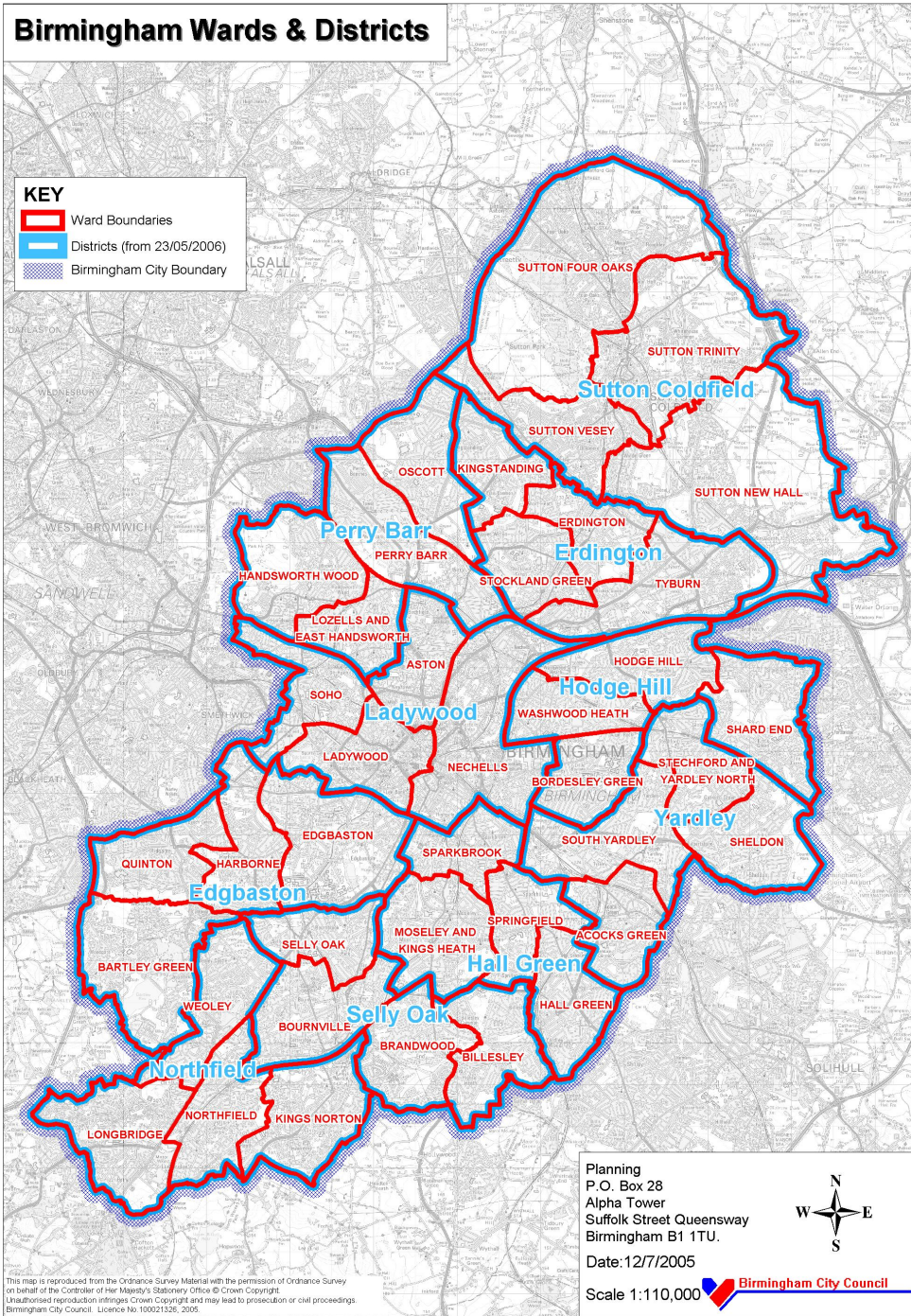

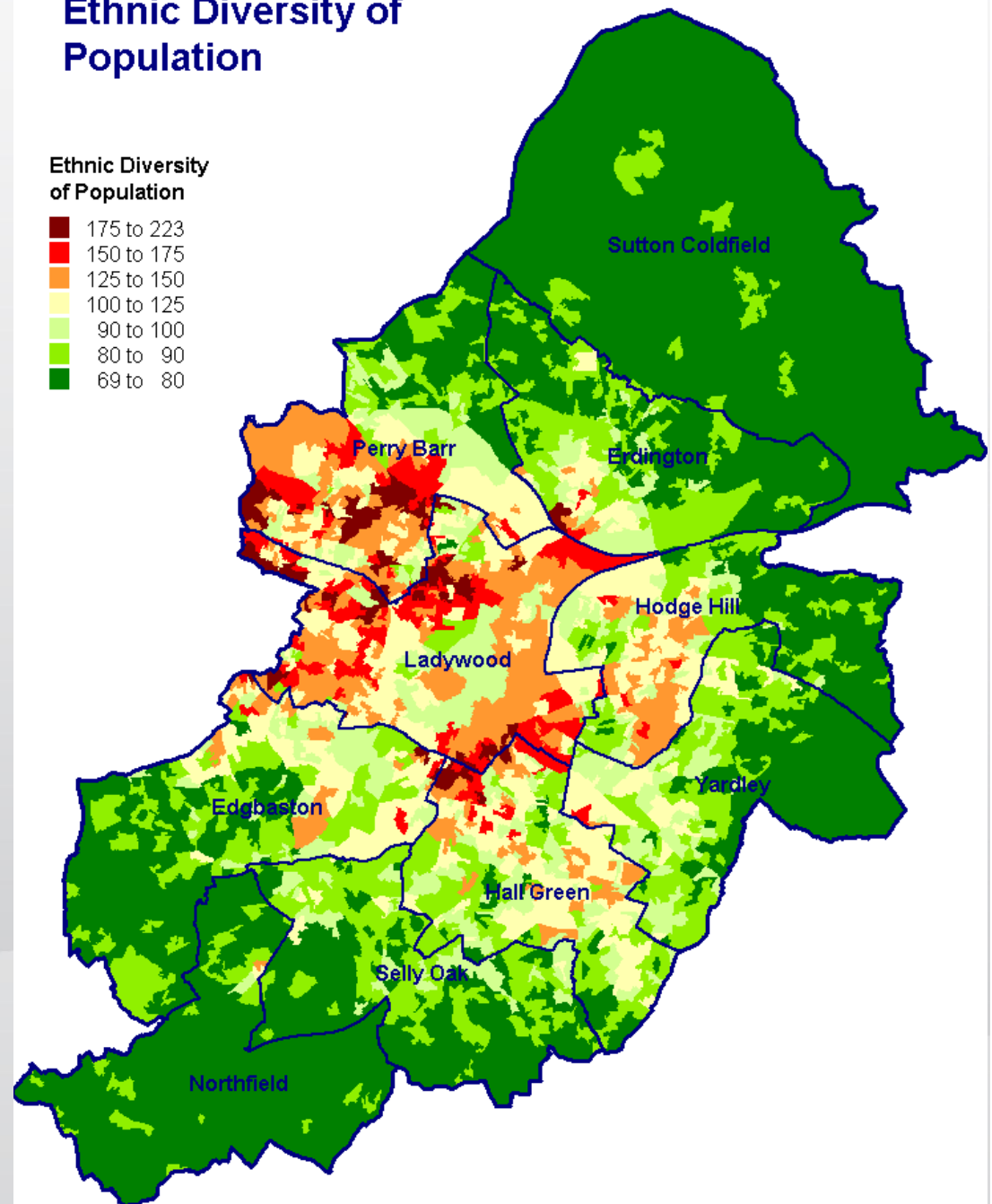
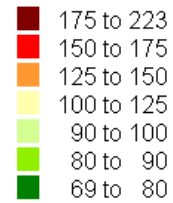
# Birmingham

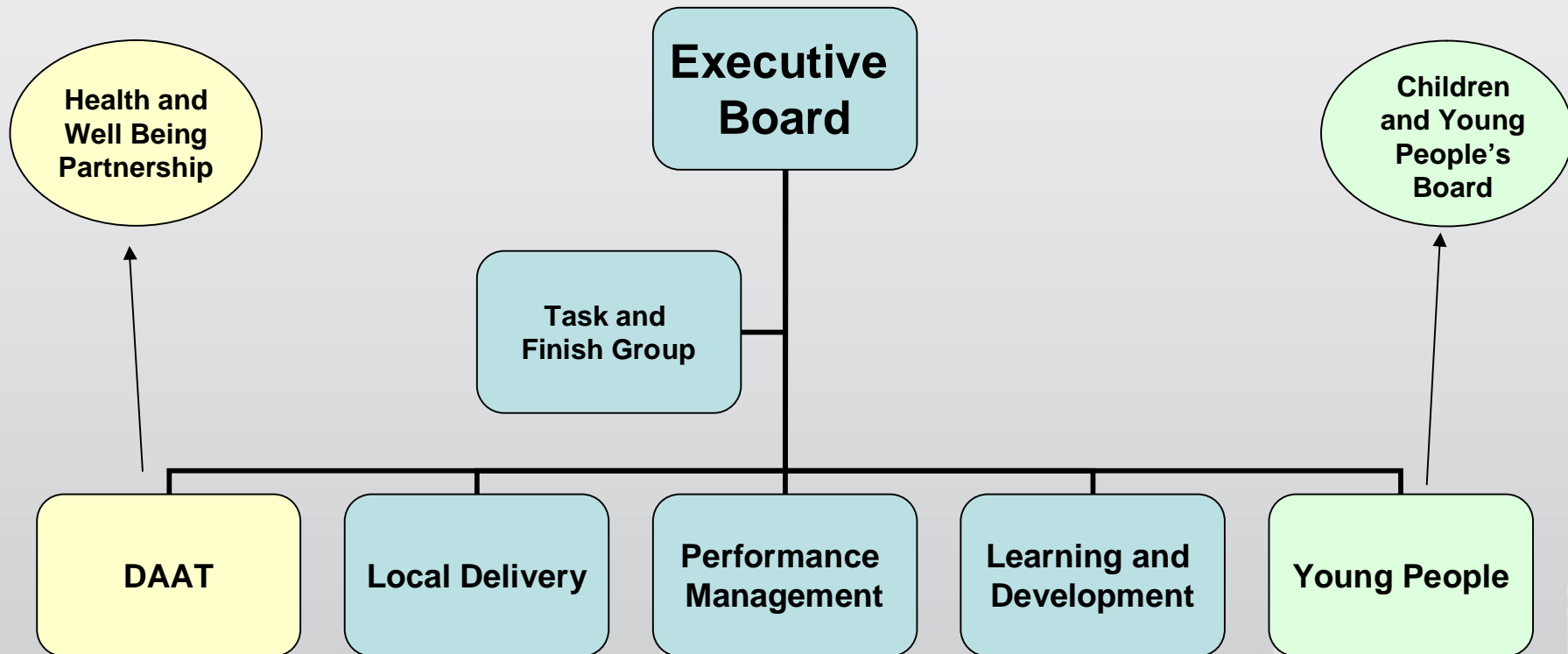


## Crime and Disorder Act 1998
